3. We will receive offerings during the service but the plates will not be passed hand to hand. You may also give by mail or online.
4. We are strongly encouraged to wear face coverings as practicable while outside our homes or place of residence, except when eating, drinking, or exercising outdoors.
5. We are still sanitizing in accordance with published guidelines.
6. Children's Church (4yrs-3<sup>rd</sup> grade) meets in E-103. A mother's nursing room and nursery care is available for children ages 1-3 in the Worship Center.
7. We ask that greetings and visits be conducted outside, before and after the service. Services will not include shaking hands.
