Romans 1:18-32 – In context- all men are unrighteous (Jew and Gentile) and need the righteousness of God

Jew - has light of Scripture Gentile - did not - BUT Both were idolatrous

Both redeemed and unredeemed man shares the same nature and apart from the truth of God's Word will walk in finite understanding

Application: Do not neglect truth – it is your freedom (John 8:32,,2 Corinthians 3:17)

When truth is forsaken, errors multiply

Application: Examine yourself – 2 Corinthians 13:5

Application: John 15 – Abide in Christ

People who neglect the truth of God - of what He has revealed of Himself that should cause us to pursue an understanding of Him – are given over to their folly. Romans 1:18-32 teaches us that.

## References for understanding terms in the culture war around homosexuality-

Sexuality relates to the biological differences between males and females. Genetics determine the 'sex' of an individual, the differences being anatomical as well as physiological and are present at birth.

Gender is more aptly described as *gender role* because particular cultures and societies influence gender through the way they define gender roles. These are expressed in norms and stereotypes for males and females that include behavior and interests (Balswick & Balswick, 2008). These roles include expectations of behavior in which males are masculine, rough and tumble, strong and aggressive, while females are expected to be gentle, feminine, and submissive.

Both sexuality and gender roles are up for debate in the culture – Reveals vain imaginations and foolish hearts that are darkened.
